Dennis asked for board support for a proposal to focus UUFCC as a community model for fighting climate change.

Suggestions include:

- Landscape with native plants that attract and support pollinators.
- Investigate the possibility of installing solar on the Fellowship. Investigate benefits and cost.
- Seek grants
- Actively engage environmental speakers at least once a month.
- Fly flags that celebrate the environment.
- Bring together environmental groups in the area.
- Renew Green sanctuary status
- Provide classes that are highly publicized and open to all.
- What we can do to support the environment?
- Investigate/choose curricula. Curricula available from UUA
- Re-establish the Climate Action Committee as a Climate Task Force
- Have a speaker series

Immediate action to be taken:

- Laura A will ask Worship associates if it is appropriate/desirable to have a monthly service on this topic.
- Dennis will contact folks to be part of a steering committee
- Fellowship meeting will be held to get buy in from all.

Sharon moved and Betty seconded for board to support forming a task force to support UUFCC involvement in environmental matter. Motion passed.
